SWIM ENTRIES:	DEADLINE FOR THE RECEIPT OF ENTRIES IS TBD. Meet File is located here:Meet File will be emailed to each school by 2/1/22.Timeline for processing entries is going to be very tight! Please send in entries early to help this process go as quickly as possible.
	 Entries must be submitted in yards times using Hy-Tek Team Manager 7.0 or newer. Teams submit entries as an e-mail attachment
	 A Team Manager printout of entries must be included and phone number of the person to contact in case of questions must accompany the entries.
	 Swimmers may enter a maximum of <u>4 events</u>, no more than <u>two of</u> which may be individual events. Diving counts as an individual event. Coaches MUST enter their divers when they send the entry file with the swimmer names.
	 Team: Each team may enter a maximum of four entries per individual events. Each team is allowed <u>1 relay entry per relay event</u>. For administrative purposes, please enter relays with names. Relay names can be changed at meet. Be sure that all relay only swimmers or alternates are entered in the meet.

	 Confirmation of your entries will be sent. Entries will need to be double checked and any changes sent by noon on Wednesday, February 2nd.
	• Psych sheet will be sent out once all entries are confirmed. Unless an error has been made by the meet management, no changes will be made.
	• By submitting entries, coaches are certifying that all swimmers are eligible and achieved times at a VHSL meet during the 2022-2023 season.
DIVE ENTRIES:	DEADLINE FOR RECEIPT OF ENTRIES IS 2/1/22. • Diving entries: Enter all divers in meet with your entry file and submit diving information using online directions. Dive sheets are to be emailed

SCRATCHES:	 All swimmers listed in the heat sheet are considered as entered in the meet. If you have swimmers who are entered, but need to scratch either a single event or all events, provide names and events to the Head Referee at the Coaches Meeting PRIOR to the start of meet. It is very important that the swimmers get to the blocks on time for their events. If a swimmer no shows for events without scratching, they will be disqualified from further competition at the meet.
OBSERVED SWIMS FOR USA SWIMMING:	 This meet will be observed in accordance with USA Swimming Rules for the purpose of receiving a reportable USA Swimming time or record. Please make sure that you have the following information included in your event file for each athlete to be observed: first name, middle initial, last name, birthday, and ID Please include a list of swimmers to be observed in email with entries along with their USA Swimming ID number.
AWARDS:	Individual events: Medals will be awarded to the 1 st -3rd place. Relay events: Medals will be awarded to the 1 st – 3rd place. Team: Trophies will be awarded for 1 st place for both the boys and girls. Awards will be distributed at the conclusion of Finals for all events.
RULES:	 Please remind your athletes of the following VHSL rules prior to the meet: Cap and suit rule, tape rule, electronic timing rule, false start rule, and unsportsmanlike conduct. Shaving and deck changing is forbidden on site at all NFHS events and will result in the athlete being removed from further participation. Championship Meets: If an athlete misses an event, he or she is disqualified in all other events. Swimmers with disabilities or medical approved needs per VHSL MUST be reported to Meet Referee prior to Meet start Each team will provide their own individual lap counter (equipment is provided) for their 500-yard freestyle swimmers – only 1 counter per
OFFICIALS:	Iane. Meet Referee: Michael Sizemore • Officials for all positions (dry and wet) will be required for this meet. • All teams should email Bianca West westbk@staffordschools.net with names and contact information for all officials by TBD • Officials shall be certified by VHSL to officiate championship meets
SAFETY:	 Swimmers will enter water feet first during warm-up and any time in the warm- up/down area. All athletes, coaches, and spectators must follow facility rules and any directions/requests made by facility staff or lifeguards. Injuries must be

	reported to lifeguards, the meet director, and meet referee immediately. • Athletes, coaches, and spectators are not permitted to leave the pool area to enter the gym or basketball court at any time.
TIMERS and VOLUNTEERS:	 All participating schools will need to provide timers and volunteers in addition to the officials listed above. Through the duration of the meet, we will need 24 Timers, 2 Head Timers, 1 runner, (check on # of stroke and turn) and 6 Marshals (combination of male/female). A sign-up genius will be created and sent to team coaches for volunteers to sign-up for preliminary sessions. Finals sessions will need to be staffed by volunteers at the meet. Timer lane assignments and volunteer assignments will be emailed out once entries are submitted for prelims. Volunteers assigned responsibilities will be admitted for free into the event. It's necessary to check in at the admission table upon arrival.
GENERAL:	 Hospitality: light food and drinks will be provided to coaches and officials. Admission: \$10 for spectators. Passes will be accepted at the door (VHSL, VIAAA, VSBA, VHSCA). Tickets will be available on TicketSpicket.com Program/Heat sheets will be available for sale at the concession stand for spectators, but Coaches and Officials will be provided copies. Information on commemorative shirts will be provided separately
FACILITY RULES:	 All participants, volunteers, workers, and spectators are expected to follow the posted rules of the Rouse Center as well as follow directions/rules given by lifeguards, pool staff and/or management. No flash photography/videography allowed during competition. No artificial noise makers will be permitted (drums, horns, bells, whistles, etc. No outside food or drink is permitted in the facility other than water and coffee, with the exception that participating athletes may bring in food and drink preferred for competition. Concessions will be allowed in the stands, but trash must be properly disposed of in the trash cans provided. Permitted drinks must be in plastic bottles or covered cups. Guests need to enter the pool area through the doors in the wet corridor. Signs will be posted to show guests where to go. Observers are to stay in designated area. Guests are not allowed to use any part of the facility other than the pool area and restrooms (i.e. guests are not allowed to work out in the gym or play basketball unless they purchase a day pass.) Young children must be supervised by an adult. Blue painters tape may be used inside to hang signs, banners or decorations, however they cannot cover any of the sponsor advertisements on the walls. Please consult with the Competitive Coordinator prior to hanging up any relevant decorations. Nothing with glitter is allowed in the facility No smoking is permitted within the Rouse Center.

STATE QUALIFIERS (Class 6):	Participation is open to Virginia High School League (VHSL) Class 6 swimmers/divers who meet all VHSL eligibility criteria for participating in sports, and the following competition standards:
	Swimming: 1. Achieve a VHSL qualifying time in one or more individual or relay events.

 A qualifying time may be obtained during any 2021-2022 regular season High School meet, a VHSL sanctioned invitational, or in the school's District or Regional Championship meet. A qualifying time must be achieved in High School competition. USA Swimming and YMCA times are not allowed. 2. Top 5 finish in individual events in his/her Regional championship. 3. Top 4 finish in relay events in his/her Regional Championship. *** Automatic qualifiers must still be entered by coach/team through the meet entry procedures.
Diving: Obtain a State qualifying diving score during a VHSL sanctioned invitational, District or Regional Championship. Score must have been obtained during this current sports season (winter 2021-2022). Scores must have been achieved in 11-Dive format competition. All top 5 Regional qualifiers are eligible to advance to the state meet. Qualifying divers must also meet requirements for championship meets as specified in the 2021-2022 National Federation of State High School Association Rulebook. No USA Diving, YMCA Diving, AAU Diving scores are allowed. *** All divers must still be entered by coach/team through the Hy-Tek entry file in addition to the dive sheet entry procedures.
